### APPLICATION RATES

Lawns:	40 pounds / 1500 sq ft 2x/year
New sod / turf:	40 pounds / 1000 sq ft
Potting:	1/2 cup / pound of soil
Gardens - top dressing:	40 pounds / 3500 sq ft
Trees:	2 cups per caliper inch

This handmade Lotka paper is made from the bark of the Daphne bush which regenerates naturally, providing a renewable resource. Lotka paper is acid-free and supports the economic enterprise of rural craftspeople in Nepal.

Plant this wildflower seed paper in your planter or garden by covering with 1/8" of soil. Sprinkle on a heaping tablespoonful of MightyGrow Living Organic Fertilizer. Pat the soil down firmly and water. The seeds must be kept moist for 4-6 weeks and will need 4 hours of sunlight each day in order to germinate properly. Many wildflowers are drought tolerant once established, but must receive adequate water as they sprout.
